Back story: Weekly our chapter relies on rotating teams of fantastic volunteers who pack food bags for the elementary school children signed up for our program (middle and high school staff pick up food needed for kids in their programs).

Packing teams consist of 4+ people who sign up to come in monthly to pack on their designated week. Again, we are seeking a team to pack bags and deliver on week 3 of each month. Bag packing numbers are approximately 70 bags. A team of 4+ makes the work fast and easy! Teams typically pack Tuesday or Wednesday at whatever preferred time. Some teams pack after work and some pack during the day. Bags can be dropped off to the two elementary schools anytime during school hours prior to Thursday noontime. This volunteer role takes no more than two hours monthly and occurs every third week. It's such a simple way to give back!
