

CASA of New Hampshire provides a voice for abused and neglected children and youth by empowering a statewide network of trained volunteers to advocate on their behalf so they can thrive in safe, permanent homes. It is CASA's job is to bring to the attention of the court what is in the best interest of these children and youth, many of whom end up in our state's foster care system as a result of the abuse or neglect they've suffered.

CASA-NH has represented more than 10,000 children in the last 31 years and last year alone, more than 600 volunteers provided advocacy for more than 1,400 children. It's CASA's goal to provide a voice for 100% of NH's victimized children.

Childhood food insecurity is a national problem, it occurs when children receive insufficient food on a regular basis; in many cases missing meals entirely. There are more than 16 million food insecure children in America today.

End 68 hours of Hunger puts nourishing food in the hands of school children to carry them through the weekend. Each bag of food costs \$10 each week and provides two breakfasts, two lunches, and three dinners for a child, with some left over to share!
